The Albany Police Department continues to provide the community with the tools and resources to help keep them informed and safe.

The Albany Police Department wants to remind citizens that California's Megan's Law was enacted in 1996 and allows the California Department of Justice (CA DOJ) to provide information to the public about specified registered sex offenders.

The Megan's law website (<https://www.meganslaw.ca.gov/>) is a source for citizens to obtain information about registered sex offenders. Please be aware sex offenders who are registered as transient may not appear on the website unless you do the following steps when exploring the website:

- Check the **INCLUDE TRANSIENT OFFENDERS** box located on the left side of the screen
- Click the **SHOW LIST** link at the top middle of the page
