**A RESOLUTION OF THE ALBANY CITY COUNCIL ACCEPTING  
PHASE IV PLANS FOR THE LOWER CODORNICES CREEK  
RESTORATION PROJECT AND AUTHORIZING STAFF TO IDENTIFY  
ADDITIONAL FUNDING FOR PROJECT CONSTRUCTION**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Albany has partnered with the City of Berkeley and the University of California since the late 1990s to restore the portion of lower Codornices Creek between San Pablo Avenue and the train tracks as a vital riparian habitat and a resource to the community; and

**WHEREAS**, the first few phases of the project have been completed successfully, and the City must move forward with Phases IV and V to complete the restoration and trail connection; and

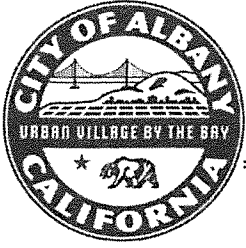
**WHEREAS**, the City of Albany has been working with Restoration Design Group to develop plans for Phase IV of the project, which includes a bicycle and pedestrian shared-use path from 8<sup>th</sup>-10<sup>th</sup> Streets, a crossing at 8<sup>th</sup> street to link to the Phase III project, and minor vegetation improvements; and

**WHEREAS**, the final plans for the project reflect extensive community stakeholder engagement.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Albany City Council hereby accepts the Phase IV plans for the Lower Codornices Creek Restoration Project; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Albany City Council authorizes staff to identify additional funding for project construction.
